LAMDA Requirements Public Speaking Grade 2

Here are the LAMDA knowledge requirements for grade 2 public speaking ©

Grade 2 public speaking:

The Learner will deliver a prepared speech about an object of their own choice from memory.

The speech must not exceed three minutes in length. Note cards may be used.

Visual aids must be used and referred to.

Knowledge:

The learner will answer questions on the following:

- How was the speech prepared?
- Give a detailed answer talking the examiner through all the steps from choosing your topic, brainstorming, writing a hook sentence, choosing a structure, practicing, editing, choosing a visual aid (if you're using one) and incorporating it, putting the speech onto cue cards and practicing some more.
 - The learner will present the examiner with a choice of **two topics.** The Examiner will choose one of these topics and use it to initiate a conversation with the Learner. The Learner must ask questions to further the conversation
- *Other things to think about for grade 2. Your speech must not exceed three minutes in length. Note cards may be used. In grade 2 the learner MUST use a visual aid, and it must be referred to.
