Grade 4 public speaking:

Exam Requirements:

The learner will prepare two speeches for this exam no longer than 4 minutes in length.

The first speech topic will be chosen from this list:

My Favourite Film

Family Life

The Environment

Someone I would like to meet (past or present)

The Second speech can be on a subject of their choice.

Students **MUST** choose an imagined audience for each speech.

Students **MUST** have a visual aid for **ONE** of their speeches and it must be referred to and integrated into their speech. Remember that a visual aid should support your speech. Make sure that your visual aid is **VISUAL**.

Knowledge Section of the exam

The learner will answer questions on the following:

- The reasons behind the choice of subject for each prepared speech

Why did you choose this topic? Why is it important to you? Do you have a personal connection to your topic?

- The research undertaken to prepare both speeches

Be specific. What websites did you look at? Who were the articles you read written by? What part of your speech did your research help you with? Did you talk to friends and family? Listen to a podcast? Watch a Ted Talk? Watch a documentary? All of this is research.

The examiner will then present the learner with a choice of three topics. The learner will choose one of these topics and use it to initiate a conversation with the examiner. The Learner must ask questions to further the conversation.

*Remember, a conversation is a back and forth. You must ask the examiner questions, be interested in their answers and do not answer their questions with yes/no answers.
